Investment Strategy

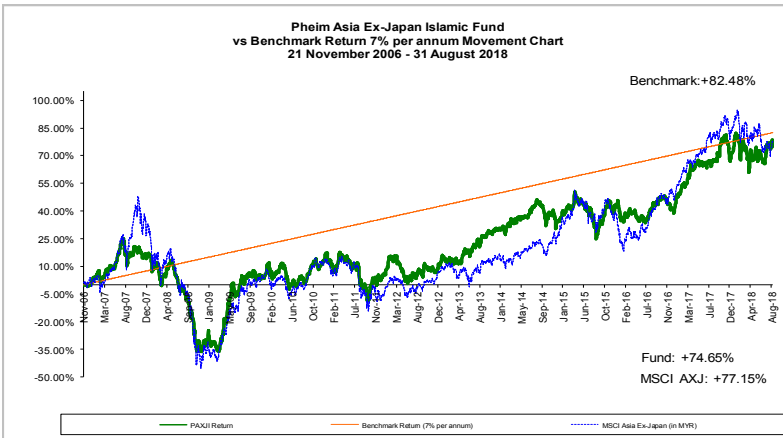
The Fund will invest in securities listed on the stock exchanges of the Asia Pacific region excluding Japan that comply with Shariah requirements.

The Fund's asset allocation is:

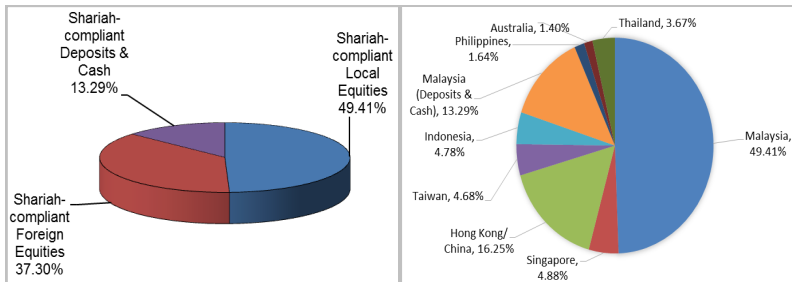
