Investment Strategy

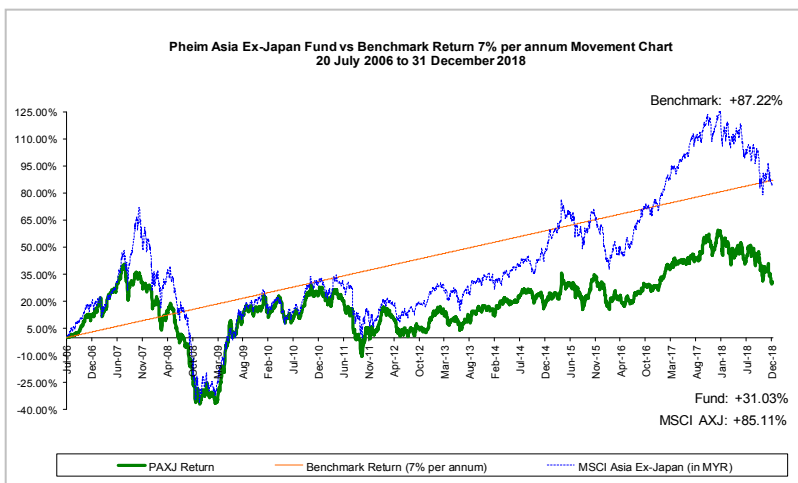
The Fund will invest, without restraint, in securities listed on the stock exchanges of the Asia Pacific region excluding Japan.

The Fund's asset allocation is:

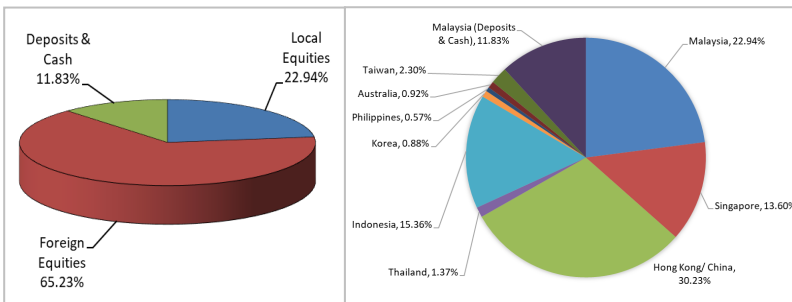
